Pietermaritzburg, which is about a one hour's drive from our fly-in port, Durban, has hosted many National BMX Championships in the past.

Sunday, 25 July	Orientation/sightseeing tour of Pietermaritzburg and hinterland
Monday, 26 July	Free day/practice/take optional tour PM: Welcome function and BMX briefing from Australian Team Manager
Tuesday, 27 July	BMX World Championships official practice commences
Wednesday, 28 July	Practice continues
Thursday, 29 July	BMX World Championships competition commences
Friday, 30 July	Competition continues
Saturday, 31 July	Competition continues
Sunday, 1 August	Final day of competition
Monday, 2 August	BMX Tour ends for some... Coach transfer Durban International Airport, fly via Johannesburg to Australia Post touring begins - See Optional Touring

## AIRFARES

Best available Qantas or South African Airways airfares will be quoted at the time of booking, departing Australia 24 July and Durban 2 August. Direct flight fares from Australia to Johannesburg are estimated at \$2,462 ex Sydney and \$2,297 ex Perth, plus airline taxes of approx. \$450 pp. Quotes will be given for longer stays. Group fares will be available shortly and will be quoted on request. If you want to travel with the main group, you will depart with the Australian Team Manager from Sydney on Saturday, 24 July 2010. NB: Airlines charge a bike carriage fee if your baggage is over and above the set allowance; however, Events Worldwide will ask the airline to support BMX riders. The additional cost will be advised once final numbers are known.
